\$50	A Box of Nails...the basic support for a family’s new home
\$50	A Bedroom Wall...so a child can sleep in heavenly peace
\$150	Bathroom Sink & Faucet...to clean up after a hard day’s work
\$200	Storm Door...for a friendly hello and goodbye
\$200	One Window...to bring in the morning light and fresh air
\$225	One Interior Door & Hardware...so each family member can have privacy
\$350	Water Heater...for a hot shower – and a child’s bubble bath
\$450	Interior Paint...to make a home bright and cheery
\$500	Light Fixtures...for reading a book in the evening – and doing homework
\$500	Landscaping...to beautify both the house and the neighborhood
