...and hungry, with no place to sleep? In an effort to bring awareness to the plight of 150,000 homeless Ohioans, Delaware County Habitat for Humanity and its Youth United team are hosting **Shack City 2011** in downtown Delaware from 7 p.m. Saturday, Nov. 12, until Sunday morning, Nov. 13.

You can be a part of Shack City

Students, youth groups and organizations are invited to use cardboard boxes and tape — instead of wood and nails — to build their homes for one night. Raise awareness for those who live with no roof over their heads. Every dollar donated goes to build or renovate homes in partnership with Delaware County families.



On any given night, 730,000 people in the U.S. are homeless. Children make up one-fourth of the homeless population.

Shack City 2011—the details. . .

- \$25 (minimum) in sponsorships to participate, ask your family and friends. This includes pizza & breakfast.
- \$30 in donations scores a **Shack City** t-shirt.
- Get sponsors for **Shack City** using the form on the back, make as many copies as you need. We dare you to fill them all.
- Turn in all your sponsor forms & donations at **Shack City**.

New for 2011: Bring in one or more canned food item for a donation to People In Need.

- Participants and their parent/guardian must sign and bring the Habitat "Release and Waiver of Liability" form (attached). Youth under 18 years of age must also bring the signed participant permission form (also attached).
- Habitat Youth United adults/volunteers will chaperone. Groups of 5 or more should bring their own adult chaperone.

Release and Waiver of Liability for Minors

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY! THIS IS A LEGAL DOCUMENT THAT AFFECTS YOUR LEGAL RIGHTS! YOU MUST HAVE A SIGNED WAIVER BEFORE VOLUNTEERING!

This Release and Waiver of Liability (the "Release") executed on this _____ day of _____, 201__ by _____ (Volunteer), a minor child (the "Volunteer"), and _____, the parent having legal custody and/or the legal guardian of the volunteer (the "Guardian"), in favor of Habitat for Humanity International, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, and Delaware County Habitat for Humanity, an Ohio nonprofit corporation, their directors, officers, employees, and agents (collectively, "Habitat").

The Volunteer and Guardian desire that the Volunteer work as a volunteer for Habitat and engage in the activities related to being a volunteer (the "Activities"). The Volunteer and Guardian understand that the Activities may include but are not limited to, constructing and rehabilitating residential buildings, working in the Habitat offices, working in Habitat's ReStore or Warehouse and living in housing provided for volunteers of Habitat.

The Volunteer and Guardian hereby freely, voluntarily, and without duress executes this Release under the following terms:

Release and Waiver. Volunteer and Guardian do hereby release and forever discharge and hold harmless Habitat and its successors and assigns from any and all liability, claims, and demands of whatever kind or nature, either in law or in equity, which arise or may hereafter arise from Volunteer's Activities with Habitat.

Volunteer and Guardian understand that this Release discharges Habitat from any liability or claim that the Volunteer and Guardian may have against Habitat with respect to any bodily injury, personal injury, illness, death, or property damage that may result from Volunteer's Activities with Habitat, whether caused by the negligence of Habitat or its officers, directors, employees, or agents or otherwise. Volunteer and Guardian also understand that Habitat does not assume any responsibility for or obligation to provide financial assistance or other assistance, including but not limited to medical, health, or disability insurance in the event of injury or illness.

It is the policy of Habitat that children under the age of 14 not be allowed on a Habitat worksite while there is construction in progress. It is further the policy of Habitat that, while children between the ages of 16 and 18 may be allowed to participate in construction work, ultra hazardous activity such as using power tools, excavation, demolition or working on rooftops is not permitted by anyone under the age of 18.

Medical Treatment. Volunteer and Guardian do hereby release and forever discharge Habitat from any claim whatsoever which arises or may hereafter arise on account of any first aid, treatment, or service rendered in connection with the Volunteer's Activities with Habitat or with the decision by any such representative or agent of Habitat to exercise the power to consent to medical or dental treatment as such power may be granted and authorized in the Parental Authorization for Treatment of a Minor Child.

Assumption of the Risk. The Volunteer and Guardian understand that the Activities included work that may be hazardous to the Volunteer, including, but not limited to, construction, loading and unloading, and transportation to and from the work sites.

Volunteer and Guardian hereby expressly and specifically assumes the risk of injury or harm in the Activities and releases Habitat from all liability for injury, illness, death, or property damage resulting from the Activities.

Insurance. The Volunteer understands that, except as otherwise agreed to by Habitat in writing, Habitat does not carry or maintain health, medical, or disability insurance coverage for any Volunteer.

Each Volunteer is expected and encouraged to obtain his or her own medical or health insurance coverage.

Release and Waiver of Liability for Minors

Photographic Release. Volunteer and Guardian do hereby grant and convey unto Habitat all right, title, and interest in any and all photographic images and video or audio recordings made by Habitat during the Volunteer's Activities with Habitat, including, but not limited to, any royalties, proceeds or other benefits derived from such photographs or recordings.

Other. Volunteer and Guardian expressly agree that this Release is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by the laws of the State of Ohio, and that this Release shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the State of Ohio. Volunteer and Guardian agree that in the event that any clause or provision of this Release shall be held to be invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, the invalidity of such clause or provision shall not otherwise affect the remaining provisions of this Release which shall continue to be enforceable.
